

## **Dr. Derrick D. Jordan**

Dr. Derrick D. Jordan earned a Bachelor of Arts in English from North Carolina Central University, a Master of Arts in School Administration from East Carolina University, and the Doctor of Education from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He currently serves as superintendent of the Chatham County Schools and is as an adjunct clinical assistant professor in the School of Education at UNC-CH. A career educator, Jordan has also taught at the middle school, high school, and community college levels.

Dr. Jordan presently serves as a member of the North Carolina Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (NCASCD) Board of Directors (the largest ASCD affiliate in the world) and served as president of the organization during the 2016-2017 year.
